



Preface

This preface describes the objectives, audience, conventions, and organization of the *Cisco DVB Interactive Network Adapter INA2320 Installation and Configuration Guide* and defines the conventions used to convey instructions and information.

Objectives

This guide provides hardware installation and software configuration instructions for the Cisco DVB Interactive Network Adapter INA2320. It contains information about the PAL frequency allocation and shows an example for a system setup. This publication also provides step-by-step instructions to install and use the INA Management Software.

Audience

This guide is intended for the following personnel:

- Technicians and engineers who physically install and configure the Cisco DVB INA2320
- Cable system administrators and support engineers who configure and maintain the Cisco DVB INA2320.

The system personnel should be familiar with Ethernet, TCP/IP configuration, IP Routing, and RF interfaces.

Appendix E	PAL Frequency Allocation	Defines frequency allocations for 8-MHz television channel bands for the PAL standard.
Appendix F	Laboratory Setup	Provides a diagram that shows you how to set up a laboratory system.
